Subject: Complaint regarding Teresa Purcell, PDC Case 17876

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on May 2, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Teresa Purcell, a 2016 candidate for State Representative, for Legislative District 19 may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), disclosing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the Campaign; RCW 42.17A.240 for failure to accurately and completely disclose debts and in-kind contributions; and RCW 42.17A.445 for personal use of campaign contributions.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the responses provided by Teresa Purcell; the applicable PDC reports filed by the Respondent; and the Stipulation and Agreed Judgment entered between the Attorney General’s Office for the State of Washington and Teresa Purcell, to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff’s review, we found the following:

- On June 1, 2018, the Thurston County Superior Court entered a Stipulation and Agreed Judgment in case 16-2-04959-34, resolving all alleged violations as asserted in the Fourth Amended Complaint, and any citizen action notice filed through the date of the judgment, including PDC Case 17876.
- The Superior Court had primary jurisdiction over the substance of the complaint, and the PDC will defer to its judgment in bringing this matter to resolution.
