Jennifer:

I am writing in response to a PDC complaint filed on 2/5/19 against the Pierce County Democrats Central Committee (PCDCC) by an individual named Glen Morgan (PDC Case No. 47065). This complaint alleges:

"Violation of RCW 42.17A.240 for failure to accurately disclose un-suspended portion of agreed penalty from Thurston County Superior Court Case 17-2-04616-34."

On October 27, 2017, the PCDCC reached a settlement with the Washington State Attorney General (Thurston County Court Case # 17-2-04616-34) for a prior PDC complaint filed by this same individual. As a condition of the settlement, which suspended half of the original \$31,780 fine, PCDCC agreed to make \$3,000 payments every six months. With this payment schedule in place, the penalty will be paid in full by June 2021. PCDCC has a process through our bank (Washington State Employees Credit Union) for making the payments. Three payments have been made to date and reported in PCDCC's C4 filings to the PDC.

Contrary to Mr. Morgan's assertion, since October 2017 when the settlement was determined, PCDCC has consistently and accurately disclosed and reported all recurring payments associated with the specified penalty.
