Subject: Complaint regarding Laurie Jenkins, PDC Case 47130

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed February 4, 2019. Your complaint alleged Laurie Jenkins may have violated RCW 42.17A.700 and RCW 42.17A.710 by “failing to disclose a corporation, association, or entity on the F-1 Personal Financial Affairs Statement in which an office, ownership, partnership, or financial interest is held.” Specifically, you alleged Jenkins failed to report her controlling interest in LM PAC.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations listed in the complaint you filed, the statutes, rules and reporting requirements, and the response to the complaint provided by Taki V. Flevaris, attorney representing Laurie Jenkins.

Based on staff’s review, we found the following:

- Laurie Jenkins was first elected to the Washington State House of Representatives, representing the 27th Legislative District, in 2010. She was reelected in 2012, 2014, 2016 and 2018.
- Laurie Jenkins is listed as Campaign Manager of LM PAC, a political committee first registered with the PDC in 2012.
- In the response, Flevaris stated, “Ms. Jenkins admittedly has not included political committee offices on her F1 financial disclosure forms to date. Such positions are already reported directly to the PDC in connection with each political committee, and the governing statutory language and regulations are not clear on whether the same information must also be included in an official’s F1 reports.”
- RCW 42.17A.710(1)(g) does not include “political committee” in the list of entities required to be reported on the F-1 Supplement, and historically, PDC staff has not

advised F-1 filers to include political committees on the F-1 Supplement when the filer holds a position of committee officer in a political committee.

Based on these findings staff has determined that, in this instance, the failure to list LM PAC on an F-1 Supplement does not appear to be an actual violation warranting further investigation.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
