As mentioned in my email of a few moments ago, we have consolidated the two complaints from Nick Minkin and retained them both under PDC Case **50698**.

You have already responded to complaint #2 from Mr. Minkin. However, we would like to give you the opportunity to respond to complaint #1, which alleges missing sponsor ID for your website <https://ginnyforshoreline.org> (see attached)

A review of the campaign's website shows sponsor ID information at the bottom of the page. However, it would be helpful to know approximately what date this was added. Based on a previous email from Bryce, it appears that the campaign's website was updated with sponsor ID on or about 4/29/19.

Please send us a supplemental response regarding sponsor ID on the website by this **Friday, May 24, 2019**. Be sure to reply directly to this email (and do not change the Subject line) to ensure your response is routed correctly in our system.
