Complaint Description

Andrew Saturn (Tue, 23 Apr 2019 at 1:02 PM)

During the 2018 election season, Linda Oosterman's campaign coordinated directly with a PAC, "Up for Thurston County (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy)" ("the PAC") via Paul Berendt, a long-time friend of Linda Oosterman and also a registered lobbyist for Puget Sound Energy (the sponsor and majority donor to the PAC) according to the PDC website, in an attempt to conceal a \$13,000 contribution to Linda Oosterman from Puget Sound Energy (see attached C3 report #100868145), and \$7,977.17 worth of in-kind electioneering communications, a last-minute contribution violation.

Not only did Paul Berendt have in-depth knowledge of the plans and strategies of the Linda Oosterman campaign, but he also acted as an executive committee office in soliciting support and direct campaign contributions, both verbally and in writing (see attached solicitation letter, handed to me by Paul Berendt on behalf of the Linda Oosterman campaign at a Thurston County Democrats meeting). Minutes of the meeting showing Paul Berendt soliciting contributions and support for Linda Oosterman as an agent for her campaign are as of this date denied to me by Thurston County Democrats. The vice chair at the time of my request was also a member of the PAC. I can happily provide multiple witnesses if necessary.

According to Linda Oosterman's campaign manager, the solicitation letter handed out by Paul Berendt was created by their campaign and the letter was not in any other way ever used or distributed or mailed to the general public (see attached email from Joe Hyer, campaign manager). General members of the public would have had no way to know about this letter or receive a copy unless they were working in close coordination with the Linda Oosterman campaign as a member of the executive committee.

On 10/31/2018, Paul Berendt spent \$16.39, reflected as an in-kind contribution for the PAC, related to SmugMug.com, a storage and sharing service for very high-resolution photographs (see attached C4 report #100876348). This is a service you would use if you needed to transfer print-quality photos too large to attach to an email. For example, GMail's file attachment limit is 25MB. A JPEG image greater than 25MB would be at least 10 megapixels, or representative of an original photo file delivered from a photographer's camera.

In emails and formal PDC complaint responses, the PAC's sole member, Jason Bennett (also of Argo Strategies), states he did not have any part in decision making for the PAC, including designing or producing the mailer, and relied 100% upon Paul Berendt

This demonstrates that photo transfer and storage was needed and directed by the PAC by Paul Berendt, and Paul Berendt received photos from elsewhere as a separate task to the design of the mailer. If Paul Berendt was truly just a vendor, and not making decisions or acting on behalf of the PAC, his SmugMug.com bill, or any other related expenses (such as his internet bill, his cell phone bill, his electricity bill, the cost of graphic design software, cost of travel, etc) would not need to be individually noted as an in-kind contribution to the PAC itself (these ancillary costs would be absorbed by his lump in-kind costs and contributions as a "vendor" offering "design services"). The fact that this cost was specifically noted illustrates that the purchase was solely for the PAC, and was directed by an officer of the PAC.

One of the photos on the PAC's mailer (attached, Linda Oosterman holding a microphone) is visually identical to a photo distributed by Linda Oosterman's campaign. The Oosterman campaign only noted one campaign transaction for photos, in C4 #100861563 filed on 9/30/2018, \$152.32 to Vento Photo for "photo." However, the Oosterman campaign's response to PDC complaint #48963 states that Linda Oosterman's campaign had the photo taken by an un-named campaign volunteer, and did not report the contribution. The photo was only available in high-resolution directly from the photographer, which is only known to Linda Oosterman's campaign. An outside PAC would have no way to know how to acquire a copy of the original photo.

The timing here is interesting: According to records provided by Capitol City Press (attached), as well as C4 #100870852, the mailer cost \$3,024.68 in printing plus \$4,952.49 in postage, and was produced just one week before the election, on 10/31/2018 (paid for on 10/29/2018).

One week earlier, a low-resolution copy of the photo was featured in the 10/19/2018 Olympian article "Low-profile Thurston PUD finds itself at center of campaign controversy" (https://www.theolympian.com/news/local/article220194240.html) where it is displayed with the caption "Courtesy Linda Oosterman," demonstrating that the photo—the first and only publicly-available copy—was supplied to The Olympian directly by the Linda Oosterman campaign, not a volunteer or member of the public.

Even though this low-resolution copy of the photo was made public on 10/19/2018 via The Olympian's article (and later heavily compressed in a video on the Oosterman campaign Facebook page), in every instance, this photo has been reduced in size and

compressed to under 1MB—not even half the size or quality as the version used in the printed mailer. Additionally, the publicly-available copy is full of blurry "JPEG artifacts," which are signs of web compression. The photo in the mailer lacks any signs of compression.

The only versions of this photo that were ever publicly available are not suitable for printing. Additionally, no publicly available copy of this photo would have necessitated 3rd party photo sharing and storage service for photos larger than 25MB. There is no way the PAC was able to locate and use a high-resolution version without coordinating directly with Linda Oosterman's campaign.

This means that in being the sole person responsible for the decision making and design of the PAC's mailer, Paul Berendt also had access to the original photo supplied by the Linda Oosterman campaign. It also means Paul Berendt provided SmugMug storage space to facilitate the delivery of the original-quality print-ready photo files to him for use in his PAC's mailer design.

According to PDC records, Paul Berendt was also heavily involved in Linda Oosterman's 2012 campaign. Paul Berendt directly contributed \$350.00 in cash (C3s #100498891 and #100483934), and alone was responsible for organizing and planning Linda Oosterman's 2012 campaign fundraiser (see attached 2012 Thurston County Democrats invite listing Paul Berendt as the event sponsor) and other events, which Linda Oosterman recognized as a direct \$275.00 in-kind contribution to her campaign (see attached C4 report #100499678).

In behavior almost identical to 2018, according to 2012 PDC records, Puget Sound Energy contributed the majority of funds for a PAC, "Alliance to Protect Thurston Power," which spent \$8,993.80 on a mailer for Linda Oosterman's campaign.

WAC 390-05-245 defines an executive committee member as "any person who alone or in conjunction with other persons makes, directs, or authorizes contribution, expenditure, strategic or policy decisions on behalf of the committee."

In conclusion:

- Paul Berendt alone organized, planned and paid for events for Linda Oosterman's campaign in 2012.
- Paul Berendt, according to the PDC website, is a long-time registered lobbyist for Puget Sound Energy, which via PACs in both 2012 and 2018, paid for printing and postage of mailers for Linda Oosterman's campaign, contributing a combined total of \$16.970.97.
- Paul Berendt was the only person to share the solicitation letter created by Linda Oosterman, and he alone solicited and arranged direct contributions for Linda Oosterman's campaign with this letter.
- Jason Bennett continues to claim that he was a ministerial-only treasurer of Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy).
- Jason Bennett claims that he did not direct Paul Berendt on how to design or create the mailer for Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy).
- Paul Berendt alone made decisions for and directed electioneering communications sent on behalf of Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy).
- Paul Berendt alone supplied SmugMug photo storage space to Linda Oosterman's campaign, who in turn provided him
 with print-ready original-quality photo files for use in the mailer paid for with funds from Up for Thurston County PAC
 (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy).
- Jason Bennett understood Paul Berendt's SmugMug.com file transfer expense to be a separate authorized
 expenditure for Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy) unrelated to his "design time" and
 filed it as an in-kind contribution of \$16.39 on 10/31/2018.
- Paul Berendt therefore falls under the definition of an executive committee member for both Linda Oosterman's 2018 campaign as well as Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy).
- Linda Oosterman was in direct coordination with Up for Thurston County PAC (Sponsored by Puget Sound Energy) via
 her close friend and registered lobbyist for Puget Sound Energy, Paul Berendt, in an attempt to conceal a \$13,000.00
 contribution from Puget Sound Energy to Linda Oosterman in 2018, and conceal the resulting \$7,977.17 of in-kind
 electioneering communications in 2018, all within one week of the election.
- These are violations of multiple parts of RCW 42.17A, including but not limited to:
 - 42.17A.205 failure to report committee officers (as defined by WAC 390-05-245)
 - 42.17A.235 failure to report other in-kind contributions
 - 42.17A.240 failure to report coordinated electioneering communications
 - 42.17A.265 failure to report last minute contributions

- 42.17A.270 failure to report earmarked contributions
- 42.17A.305 failure to report and itemize electioneering communications
- 42.17A.310 failure to report suggested and/or requested in-kind electioneering communications
- 42.17A.320 failure to list Paul Berendt as the PAC's sole committee officer on the mailer
- 42.17A.405 failure to report over-limit contributions
- 42.17A.470 failure to report an intermediary of contributions
- 42.17A.750 knowingly filing false reports and violating other sections of RCW 42.17A

Allegation #1 – The complaint appears to indicate that Danielle Westbrook is a 'member' of the campaign committee and we failed to report it. It is true that we did not report this. Since she is not, nor has ever been a member of the campaign committee. The complaint appears to indicate that Paul Berendt is an 'agent' of the campaign. While Mr. Berendt and Ms. Oosterman have been personal friends for many years - Mr. Berendt declined to participate in any part of the planning or implementation of this campaign. The complaint appears to indicate Kelsey Hulse as a member of the campaign committee, and again, the campaign failed to report it. The campaign did not report it- it isn't true. ALL decisions and authority for this campaign rested with Linda Oosterman and Shawn Myers, candidate and treasurer, with the support of a contracted consultant, Joe Hyer in September & October.

Allegation #2 – There was no contact, communication, or collaboration between the Oosterman campaign and 'Up with Thurston'. The first we were aware that 'Up with Thurston' even existed was the morning November 1, when several people receiving a postcard sent it to the campaign. To that end, there is no in-kind contribution to report.

Allegation #3 – This campaign has received no contributions at all from 'Up with Thurston PAC', in-kind or otherwise. It is difficult for zero to be over any limits.

Allegation #4 – Having received no contributions, it is also impossible to report earmarked contributions.



Invoice #683 was originally transmitted on 10/28/18, listing all ads BOOKED with approved budgets. This was to comply with 10/29 PDC C4 filing- candidate approved and I booked Facebook and The Olympian Digital in these amounts.

This invoice also has \$88.51 for copying and mailing expenses for PCOs asking for something to doorbell with. The Mailbox bills my account, and I bill the campaign.

I revised the invoice and re-sent to the treasurer with final amounts on 11/7/18 - on 11/1, I cancelled the remaining days on all ads, and the campaign went digitally dark on Facebook. That cut the final cost of several ads, and the revised invoice reflects this.


