It has come to my attention that Kate Kruller, Councilmember on the Tukwila City Council has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A).

1) Failure to timely file "statement of organization" (C1). (Violation of RCW 42.17a.210(1))

State law requires each candidate, within 2 weeks after becoming a candidate, to file a statement of organization (C1) Kate Kruller filed with King County Elections, as a candidate for Tukwila City Council, during filing week (May 13th thru 17th 2019). As of the date of this complaint she has still not filed her C1, so it is already substantially late and a clear violation of state law.

As an experienced long-time politician Kruller should know better. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you need any additional information.
