All other candidates must follow this Law; Daniel Miller is required to do the same. The Law is consistent in its enforcement. He is not listed currently as a candidate on the PDC list of candidates, nor was he in 2018 either.

I contacted Brenda Galarza, Records/Public Disclosure Officer for the Secretary of State's Office, 360-704-5220, brenda.galarza@sos.wa.gov. she sent me a copy of his Customer Receipts for credit card payment of Filing Fees, including credit card number, amount, Transaction Number and date. For 5-15-19 it was for \$487.31, with credit card ending in 3057. For 5-18-18 it was for \$477.76, with credit card ending in 3083. Unfortunately, they do not capture the name on the credit card. He is a perennial candidate, and we suspect he is financed by someone else for all of these Filing Fees.
