- 1) Commissioner Oosterman represents the PUD at Thurston County Chamber events. This is one of her assigned meetings agreed to by the other commissioners.
- 2) The admission to the TC Chamber events is usually \$25, \$30 or \$35. The PUD splits the cost between two different funds. The Oct 10, 2018 event was \$25 so 50/50 split.
- 3) Yes, the cost was \$25 and split between two funds for payment of \$12.50 each.

Just in case there is a question of inappropriate expense paid for by the PUD, Commissioner Oosterman has reimbursed the PUD for this event.

For the previous email regarding RCW 42.17a.555, this RCW talks about using a Public facility for campaigning. If this is about attending the TC Chamber event on 10/10/18, the event was held at the Hotel RL, a local hotel, not a Public facility. Commissioner Oosterman was not part of the 10/10/18 Chamber program but was asked to introduce herself and this was all.
