Dear Beth Kennar and Sandra Fowler:

After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of a complaint filed July 26, 2019 by Maxford Nelsen of the Freedom Foundation concerning Waste Treatment Completion Company, PDC staff opened a formal investigation and held a case status review, referred to as an initial hearing, on October 15, 2019, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

At the hearing it was noted that the case status review is not an adjudicative proceeding, and that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints through the use of alternatives to full, formal adjudication, or referral to the Attorney General's Office, and I am encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.
