1) **Alleged violation of RCW42.17.205 for failure to register with the PDC within 2 weeks of declaring candidacy. (C1)**


Candidate filed with King County Elections and appears in the voters pamphlet however has failed to file C1 with the PDC.

2) **Alleged violation of RCW42.17A.210 Treasurer**

Candidate has failed to designate and file the name and address of their treasurer. By failing to disclose the treasurer the public denied knowing where the campaign books are located or make an appointment for inspection of the books if "mini reporting".


3) **Alleged violation of RCW42.17A.215 Depositories**


Candidate has failed to file with the PDC where campaign funds are being held or dispersed, if any.
