I am responding to Anne Block's complaint and supplemental complaint referenced below.

Full Life Care

I served on the board of a non-profit organization called ElderHealth Northwest, the predecessor of Full Life Care, from 1992 until 1998. Since that time, the organization has listed me as an advisory board member (earlier) or an emeritus board member (in recent years). The advisory and emeritus statuses are honorary only. I have not had any authority in the organization's decision or policy making in over a decade. Once or twice over these many years the organization has invited me to a meeting of other advisory board members, but have not attended, nor have I been invited to attend, any such meeting in the past five years.

If PDC staff concludes that this information should be part of my PDC filing, I will be happy to submit an amendment. I would appreciate any guidance staff can provide on this issue.

ACLU

I have not been a member of the ACLU for many years. However, when I was in private law practice from 1982 until 2018, I served on several occasions as an ACLU cooperating attorney in a pro bono capacity. Neither I nor my former law firm received any compensation for this work.
