To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that Camille Diaz Hackler who is a 2019 candidate for the Bellingham School District, has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**).

1) Actively campaigning, before filing "statement of organization" (C1). (Violation of RCW 42.17 a.210(1) and RCW 42.17A.205)

State law requires each candidate, within 2 weeks after becoming a candidate, to file a statement of organization (C1). This candidate failed to do so within two weeks of filing week (May 2019). As of the date of this complaint **she has still not filed her C1**, which is far beyond the 2 weeks required in state law. This is a clear, unambiguous violation of state law. The general election itself is only a few days away. By violating **RCW 42.17a.210** and **RCW 41.17A.205** --failing to declare this candidate's candidacy (C1) the voters also don't know who is serving as this candidate's treasurer, who the officers of this candidate's political committee are, where this candidate is banking the campaign funds for this political campaign, what address to use when inspecting the campaign books, etc.

It is worthwhile to point out to the PDC that Hackler is a veteran experienced political candidate for office. Please see the attached 2015 and 2011 C1s which Hackler was able to file in a semi-timely manner in elections past(see attached). However, it appears this time around, in 2019, Hackler couldn't be bothered to comply.

2) History of late filings of Personal Financial Disclosure Forms (F-1) (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700)

In addition to not registering her campaign with the PDC, this candidate was a week late filing her F1 (Financial Disclosure forms) in 2018. Fortunately, they were eventually filed, and this year she was timely, but it just appears this candidate is starting to take Washington State's campaign finance laws less seriously as time goes by.

3). Failure to file Contribution or Expenditure Reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

This candidate has also failed to file any contribution or expenditure reports from her campaign. It should be noted that this failure to comply also includes a total absence of any reported information to the PDC for the public to see anything about this campaign and how it has spent the resources on this election campaign. Even if this campaign claims to be filing a "mini-reporting" campaign, their failure to provide an address to review their books means that it is impossible for the public to review the information about who is funding this campaign and how funds were spent to support this campaign.

Ghost campaigns like this one should be held accountable for a complete unwillingness to follow the state's campaign finance laws.
