To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that Krystal Marx has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws once again (**RCW 42.17A**). The details of these violations are as follows:

1) Failure to provide accurate and timely information on financial affairs statements (Violation of RCW42.17A.700 & RCW 42.17A.710)

Allegation #1 - Krystal Marx is a council member in the City of Burien. However, according to her financial affairs documents she has filed with the PDC (See F1 covering 2018 attached) over the last few years, Marx has **failed to disclose her \$7,200 annual salary** as a council member as part of her income on her financial affairs statements. Mayor Matta, for example, did disclose this information for reference (see Matta F1 attached).

It should be noted that Councilmember Marx has been fined by the Public Disclosure Commission in the for previous campaign finance violations (**PDC Enforcement Case #38795** – see attached order and fine notice issued by the PDC on October 5, 2018). Marx was fined \$250 in that instance for failing to timely file her F1 financial disclosure documents, and apparently, according to PDC records, it appears she refused to pay that fine and the fine has been sent to collections, according to PDC records on this case.

In addition, it should also be noted, for the record that Marx has been sent reminder letters by the PDC for her historic serial violations of the state's campaign finance laws. (See **PDC Enforcement Case#25726** – reminder letter attached where she failed to provide proper sponsorship identification on her campaign materials).

Allegation #2 - In addition, it should be noted that Marx appears to have potentially concealed additional income obtained through various Go Fund Me fundraising campaigns operated either on her behalf or Marx herself. Three examples of these successful campaigns are attached. It appears likely that I have not been able to discover all of these because they are often removed and deleted from the GoFundMe site upon collection of the donated funds. Please note – one of them, which apparently raised \$4,458 happened this year, and would not need to be reported on the 2018 F1, but this shows a pattern of behavior in addition to the two 2018 Go Fund Me Fundraisers which indicate this is common practice by this politician.

Please consider the fact that Washington State's Attorney General in the State of WA vs. Eyman case has been successfully arguing that contributions like this to a politician or political activist can't be considered "gifts" if they in any way reference the political position or political activity of the gift recipient. While I personally find that conclusion ludicrous and absurd, and I believe that Marx should be able to receive these gifts from friends and supporters even if she is a politician – it is not very controversial that they need to be disclosed as income on Marx's F1 report. In the

meantime, she should be warned that it is possible, based on the AG's actions in the Eyman case (assuming the AG prevails) that all gifts like these may require Marx to disclose each and every contribution to the PDC and report them as political contributions.

Allegation #3 – While not a major violation of the statute (this would probably be classified as "technical correction", it also is worth ensuring that while Marx is amending her current and historic F1s to provide the information currently being concealed from the public, that she also correct the ending date for her term of office. She was originally elected in 2017 for a 4 year term. She should be indicating 2021, rather than 2020 for the end date of this council term. In addition to ensuring that Marx be educated about the PDC rules, and it appears that she would benefit from taking the PDC's very helpful training classes to ensure her compliance improves in the future.

Marx's cavalier attitude towards the PDC reporting requirements despite the friendly and helpful reminder and fine imposed by the PDC in the past probably requires more explicit and tangible response by the PDC, unless there is no longer an expectation that incumbent politicians like this need to follow the law.

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Concealing income sources for elected, incumbent politicians is not a very transparent activity by an incumbent city councilmember. Additionally, failing to pay previous fines for also violating similar campaign finance laws in the past is not optimal behavior. The public should know what these incumbent politicians are actually doing.

Dear Chestine Edgar:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on October 5, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Krystal Marx may have violated RCW 42.17A.320 for failure to include Sponsor ID on political advertising.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Krystal Marx mailed written political advertising to voters in Burien during the 2017 election, which failed to include adequate Sponsor ID, "*on the first page or fold of the written advertisement or communication in at least ten-point type.*" RCW 42.17A.320(3)(a).
- In her response, Krystal Marx indicated that the address and name requirements were located on the envelope in which the advertising was mailed. This is explicitly prohibited by WAC 390-18-010(5)(a).
- Krystal Marx is a first-time candidate, with a relatively unsophisticated campaign, relatively modest contributions and expenditures, with no prior found violations of PDC requirements. WAC 390-37-061.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to adequately report Sponsor ID does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Krystal Marx about the importance of properly disclosing Sponsor ID on all political advertising. PDC staff expects that Krystal Marx will comply with all disclosure requirements for political advertising in the future.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.



Pursuant to the brief enforcement hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) notice sent to KRYSTAL MARX on August 16, 2018, A brief adjudicative proceeding was held on September 24, 2018, in Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington, to consider whether the Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) as an incumbent official, which was due to be filed not later than April 16, 2018, disclosing financial activities for calendar year 2017.

The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 RCW and 42.17A RCW and Chapter 390-37 WAC. Commission Chair Anne Levinson was the Presiding Officer. The Commission staff was represented by Fox Blackhorn-Delph, Compliance Coordinator. The Respondent did not participate in the hearing or submit any written materials.

Having considered the evidence, the Presiding Officer finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Respondent is a candidate for CITY COUNCIL MEMBER of CITY OF BURIEN.
2. As a candidate for election, the Respondent was required to file an F-1 report by April 16, 2018.
3. The Respondent did not file the missing F-1 report prior to the date of the hearing.
4. The Respondent has no prior violations.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above facts, as a matter of law, the Presiding Officer concludes as follows:

1. This matter was duly and properly convened and all jurisdictional, substantive, and procedural requirements have been satisfied.
2. The Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file the F-1 report by April 16, 2018.

ORDER

ON the basis of the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent is assessed a civil penalty of \$250, in accordance with the F-1 penalty schedule set forth in WAC 390-37-143, payable within 30 days of the date of the Order.

It is further ordered that the Respondent:


1. **Pay the \$250 civil penalty within 30 days of the date of this Order.**
2. **“Cease and desist” from failing to file the required PDC reports in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(4).**
3. **File the missing F-1 report disclosing financial activity for calendar year 2017 within 30 days of the date of this Order.**

In the event the Respondent fails to pay the \$250 civil penalty within 30 days of the date of the Order, PDC staff is directed to refer the matter to the Department of Enterprise Services (DES) for collection of the amount owed.

APPEALS OF INITIAL ORDER

REVIEW OF INITIAL ORDER - BY THE COMMISSION

If review of this initial order is timely requested, the full Commission will hear the matter. If the Commission is unable to schedule a meeting to consider the request within twenty (20) calendar days, this initial order becomes a final order, and any request for review will automatically be considered a request for reconsideration of a final order. *See* WAC 390-37-144(4). The matter would then be scheduled for consideration and disposition at the next Commission meeting at which it is practicable to do so.

A Respondent does not need to pay a penalty until after the Commission rules on a request for review of an initial order.

FURTHER APPEAL RIGHTS – SUPERIOR COURT

If the Commission does not receive a request for review of this initial order within twenty-one (21) calendar days, the initial order shall be the final order. *See* WAC 390-37-142(5).

Let me introduce you to my friend, Krystal. She's a mom to four beautiful kids and a public servant in King County, WA. She and her family need some help covering basic necessities like food and rent for the next couple of months, and here's why:

Krystal's family has seen some hard times recently. Her husband is a disabled combat veteran. His doctors have instructed him to take full leave for a while, as he needs to focus on his recovery and well-being. This means that her family is missing one parent's income.

Krystal is a highly qualified professional with more than 10 years of experience in the nonprofit sector, however (as has happened to many of us) she has found herself between jobs for several months now. Surprisingly, her status as a part-time elected official has actually made it harder for her to find work because her elected schedule needs to be flexible and many full-time jobs cannot accommodate that.
