ORDER FOR CONTINUANCE  
ON REQUEST FOR  
RECONSIDERATION

15 This matter was heard remotely by the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission  
16 (Commission) on March 26, 2020, by telephonic and online streaming access. Respondent  
17 Martin Morgan timely requested reconsideration of the Presiding Officer's Order issued on  
18 January 29, 2020, following a Brief Enforcement Hearing (Brief Adjudicative Proceeding) in  
19 this matter on January 23, 2020. The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and  
20 42.17A RCW, and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

21 Commissioners present both telephonically and online were David Ammons,  
22 Commission Chair (presiding); Russell Lehman, Commission Vice-Chair; and Commissioners  
23 William Downing, Fred Jarrett, and Nancy Isserlis. Also present both telephonically and online  
24 were Assistant Attorney General John S. Meader representing the Commission, Assistant  
25 Attorney General Chad Standifer representing PDC Staff, and Jennifer Hansen, PDC

1 Compliance Officer. Martin Morgan (Respondent) was provided notice of the hearing and  
2 appeared telephonically. The proceeding was open to the public as limited by Governor's  
3 Proclamation 20-25 and recorded.

## 23 I. FINDING OF FACT

24 The matter involved Martin Morgan's request that the Commission reconsider a Final  
25

1 Order issued on January 29, 2020, resulting from an Initial Hearing on January 23, 2020,  
2 regarding his candidacy for Kirkland City Council. The Presiding Officer at the Brief  
3 Adjudicative Proceeding found Mr. Morgan in violation of RCW 42.17A.205 and determined  
4 he had also violated the conditions of an Order entered on August 21, 2015, in PDC Case 16-  
5 210.

6  
7 1. The Reconsideration Hearing on March 26, 2020, was held telephonically and  
8 through online access. Each of the Commissioners, the PDC Compliance Officer, and  
9 the Respondent appeared remotely. Various technical issues made it unclear whether  
10 Mr. Martin heard the entirety of the hearing or was able to be fully heard by each  
11 Commissioner.


## 12 II. ORDER

13  
14 As a result of the technical issues, and out of an abundance of caution to ensure the  
15 Respondent has a full opportunity to be heard, the Commission's vote to deny reconsideration is  
16 withdrawn and the Hearing CONTINUED to the April 23, 2020, Regular Meeting of the  
17 Commission. At that meeting the Respondent will have an additional opportunity to present  
18 evidence and testimony in this matter and respond to any questions of the Commissioners.
