

I'm sorry for the late reply on this complaint filed against our group of volunteers and the PAC we organized this year to ensure racial discrimination is not reintroduced into our state. We've had so many emails, we just missed the original email, and are responding to this as quickly as possible.

First, we did not contract or hire anyone or any organization. We were concerned about our security due to the threats and violence against us and our volunteers during our signature collection phase, and we had mentioned our concerns. Fortunately, we had some people volunteer to help us escort our signature sheets from Bellevue to Olympia, and they helped us unload our boxes. We've had hundreds of volunteers all around the state helping us collect signatures, and this was just another volunteer effort.

From what we can tell reading the PDC rules and the law, volunteers who help us load, escort and unload boxes is perfectly legal and allowed under this state's campaign finance laws. We are grateful for the help and we are happy that our opponents didn't show up to hurt us, attack us, or destroy our hard earned signature sheets. Obviously, this complaint is just a part of this process, and we remain focused on ensuring we remain compliant with Washington State's campaign finance laws.

Please let me know if we are missing anything here from the PDC's perspective. We strive to follow the law exactly and we wish to avoid and correct any ministerial mistakes or errors that might have occurred.
