

Complaint Description

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that the SeaTac Progress PAC (sponsored by John Wyble) has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) during the current political election cycle.

1) Failure to accurately identify the address and of the PAC. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.255(5)(a))

An independent expenditure was made by this PAC, and on the C6 submitted to the PDC on 10/15/2019, a false address was used. There is no such thing as the city of "Searac" in Washington State. This PAC must be required to properly submit this C6 form with factually accurate information rather than the false information provided to the PDC.

2) Failure to accurately name the PAC (attempt to conceal the primary sponsor) (Violation of RCW 42.17A.005 (46)(i), RCW 42.17A.205 and WAC 390-16-011A)

This PAC has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws by failing to properly name the PAC itself. **RCW 42.17A.005 (46)(i)** clearly requires the name of this PAC to be SeaTac Progress PAC (Sponsored by John Wyble) because John Wyble represents \$10,000 of the \$10,100 worth of contributions received by this PAC, which is far more than the 80% threshold required to identify the sponsor of the PAC in the name of the PAC itself (See **WAC 390-16-011A**). The PAC is incorrectly identified and named on its C1PC, and C3 and C4 filings (see attached).

3) Failure to properly report sub-vendor information (Violation of WAC 390-16-205)

On the attached C6, this PAC has identified expenditures to "WinPower Strategies," however, Winpower Strategies is entirely owned by John Wyble, the same person who theoretically gave the \$10,000 listed on the attached C3. However, in listing the printing of these mailers, this PAC has failed to properly break down how these expenditures are actually spent – for example, how much is spent on the printer, versus the person (or entity) who designed the flyer, and how much is Jon Wyble pocketing for himself as profit? This needs to be properly reported per **WAC 390-16-205**.

It should be noted that the AG lawsuit against Tim Eyman is alleging this exact same violation where the manager of a PAC is self-dealing to himself. John Wyble appears to be doing exactly that in this instance.

4) Failure to provide accurate address for primary contributor (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-034)

The contribution from John Wyble as reported in the attached C3 report lists an address in Roslyn, WA. However, according to documents filed with the Secretary of State (see attached) for Winpower Strategies, John Wyble's address is actually at 19550 INTERNATIONAL BLVD STE, 103, SEATAC, WA, 98188.

Let me know if you need any additional information. It seems likely there are more violations to come in this case.

To whom it may concern,

I wanted to add one additional piece of evidence further supporting the recent complaint I filed against SeaTac Progress PAC (sponsored by John Wyble), and also correct a mistake I made in the original complaint.

First, the mistake. In allegation #2, which was the "**Failure to accurately name the PAC (attempt to conceal the primary sponsor) (Violation of RCW 42.17A.005 (46)(i), RCW 42.17A.205 and WAC 390-16-011A)**" the C3 and C4 is properly labeled as "sponsored by John Wyble," however, the C1PC is not.

Additionally, as related to allegation #4 which was "**Failure to provide accurate address for primary contributor (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-034)**" I have attached additional evidence indicating that the address for John Wyble's contribution is not accurate. I've attached a report from the Washington State Secretary of State showing that his voter registration address is also in SeaTac, NOT Roslyn as claimed in the C3 filed with the PDC
