I am responding to this complaint. I have reviewed RCW 42.17A.240 (d)(6) as shown below and found nothing regarding a requirement for the number of signs to be submitted.

"The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures. An incidental committee only must report on expenditures, made and reportable as contributions as defined in RCW 42.17A.005, to election campaigns. For purposes of this subsection, commentary or analysis on a ballot proposition by an incidental committee is not considered an expenditure if it does not advocate specifically to vote for or against the ballot proposition; "

When I made the purchase for signs using a personal credit card, I consulted Mr. Scott Haley of the Disclosure Commission for the process of how to document the expenditure reports. I believe that I followed his instructions.

I look forward to discussing this further and wish to be in compliance if it is determined that I am not.
