Egan is currently occupying a commercial space at 2015 E Union Street in Seattle. According to his campaign's Facebook page they have been using the space as a campaign headquarters since at least 9/6/19. News media has also reported that the space is being used as a campaign office and Egan has painted a mural on the door of the building.

Egan's PDC disclosure does not include either an expense for renting the space or a contribution for an in-kind donation of space. This seems to be a violation reporting laws. Additionally, if the space is being donated to the campaign the building landlord is most certainly over the individual contribution limit, as commercial rents in Seattle would put rent on the space over \$1,000/ month.

**What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?**

It created unfair competition in an election and unfairly benefits one candidate over the other.
