Hi Tabitha,

I was so confused by this complaint, until I did a little research on Mr. Morgan and it all became clear. Having said that, and having read his complaint, it certainly appears I did not provide enough information on a few of our C4 expenditures in 2015.

As a first time candidate, and a last minute one at that (he was approached to run merely a week before the filing deadline), Mark and I (his wife) were not fully prepared for the intricacies of all of the required reporting. I have some bookkeeping experience, and was told it would not be difficult to be the Treasurer for his campaign and therefore I volunteered.

I did not read the specific RCWs pertaining to the exact information required to explain expenditures, and assumed that listing "rack cards" and "yard signs" would be sufficient. It appears from Mr. Morgan's complaint that it is not. I will spend valuable time this weekend going through our 2015 paperwork and will submit amended 2015 C4 reports with the updated information Mr. Morgan is seeking.

As for the 2015 filing fee, we paid that out-of-pocket and again, I will admit to not understanding how that should have been reported. I will submit an amended C4 from 2015 to correct that as well.

As to the discrepancy in the ending balance from 2015 and beginning balance 2019, I can't imagine what happened, but I will look into it, find out, and submit an amended report.

I can say for a fact that neither Mark or I attempted to hide any campaign contributions. I can assure you that any discrepancy was merely an oversight on my part as his Treasurer, and I will do what's needed to correct the reports so carefully reviewed by Mr. Morgan.
