To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that, once again, as is customary for this gang, the SeaTac Progress PAC (sponsored by John Wyble) has violated and continues to violate Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) during the current political election cycle.

Please note, these are in addition to the previous violations committed by this PAC as outlined in **PDC enforcement case # 58914**

1) Concealment of the top 5 donors on political mailer (Violation of RCW 42.17A.320)

The attached mailer produced by this PAC was received in voters mailboxes on Saturday October 19th. It shows the following persons as the "Top 5 Contributors"

John Wyble
Andrea Newman
AJ Campenelli
Abdirahman Yussuf
Richard Harwood

These same people were listed on this PAC's C3 (**See PDC Report # 100940031**) as donating on these dates:

John Wyble -- \$10,000 -- 9/30/19
Andrea Newman -- \$200 -- 10/11/19
AJ Campenelli -- \$111 -- 10/11/19
Abdirahman Yussuf -- \$100 -- 10/11/19
Richard Harwood -- \$100 -- 10/11/19

However, **this person** actually donated more the same day (**See PDC Report #100940031**), and it was actually reported by the PAC on their C3, so John Wyble is clearly attempting to conceal the real top 5 donors and willfully breaking the law with malice aforethought:

Lucinda Grande -- \$1000 -- 10-11-19

While Mr. Wyble chose to list 4 "top 5 donors" who he was not required to list on the mailer due to the fact the size of their contributions don't meet the legal thresholds required and defined in **RCW 42.17A.320**, (which is perfectly legal) he completely failed to report the true top 5 donors (which is illegal and one of the areas where he broke the law), including the above donor "Lucinda Grande" who certainly would be required to be listed on that flyer. This was not an accident, this is an experienced political consultant and treasurer with years of experience who has made substantial sums of money doing this for a living. He knows the law, and he is mocking it here with the expectation nothing will happen to him. His historic experience failing to comply with the law with no consequences has convinced him that breaking the law is no big deal.

This is a pattern of concealing the Top 5 donors from the PDC and the voters.

Incidentally, SEIU donated \$3000 on 10/17/19 (See **PDC report # 100940032**)-- 2 days before mailers arrived in the voters' mailboxes. **IF** this donation was really received on the 17th, then it is understandable to not be identified on the mailers, since the timing of printing MIGHT have prevented it. However, given the historic pattern of deception committed by this PAC, and the toxic reputation SEIU has cultivated in the community, it is more likely this is part of the pattern to deceive the public and an attempt to obscure that SEIU is involved in this campaign. What makes this attempt to deceive the public by this Seattle based PAC more likely is the fact that in SEIU's own reporting, they made this contribution on 10/9/2019 (See **PDC report # 100937766**). Generally, most of SEIU's other contributions made around this time were reported timely by the recipients – but not in this case.

Finally, as further evidence that might indicate this PAC is hiding the true list of top 5 contributors to this campaign, the Teamsters Legislative League PAC (see **PDC report # 100938006**) also reported a contribution made to this PAC on 10/11/2019, which would also have been required to be listed in the top 5 donors, but was willfully concealed by this PAC from the public as well.

Clearly, due to the poor reflection it would have on this PACs perception in the community, and in an effort to conceal the fact that this PAC has minimal local support and primarily special corporate interests like these from Seattle are attempting to influence the local election, this PAC has chosen to conceal the true source of the top 5 donors on this mailer.

2) Failure to identify the correct donor address information on contribution reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240)

On the C3 dated 10/21/2019 (**PDC Report# 100940032**) Mia Gregerson donated \$150 and the PAC claims she lives at 3773 So 170th St in SeaTac. However, her voter address is 19220 39th Ave So in SeaTac (see attached report from the Secretary of State) – which happens to be the same address from which John Wyble votes.

This is false information reported on this C3, known to be false by John Wyble when this C3 was doctored to reflect a false address. Both Mia Gregerson and John Wyble pretend and claim to be living in different places, (when they donate to campaigns at least), but they are both actually voting from the same address in SeaTac. If they truly do live in different places, then this may just be a case of voter fraud, which is not uncommon in King County, but it appears more likely that this is just another routine violation of the state's campaign finance laws by John Wyble with the expectation that the law really doesn't apply to him anyway.

I am unaware, at this time, of any additional property asset transfers or off the books asset transfers beyond what I already detailed in my previous complaint (See **PDC Enforcement Case #59019**) between Representative Mia Gregerson and her campaign manager John Wyble.
