<p><u>Glen Morgan</u> reported via the portal Mon, Oct 21, 2019 at 7:28AM</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that Washington Fairness PAC has committed serious violations of Washington State’s campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A).</p> <p>1) Failure to properly identify top contributors in political television (and Youtube) advertising (Violation of RCW 42.17A.320)</p> <p>This PAC has produced a video – linked here on Youtube:</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Hm6y9LhrkIs</p> <p>This was a 30second ad also aired on television. Since at least two of the top 5 donors identified in the Pac message are Incidental committees (as defined in RCW 42.17A.005 (27))– further detail is required of the top contributors to those incidental committees. Specifically, the ACLU and the Group Health Community Foundation and the Seattle Foundation must disclose their top contributors in this ad as well.</p> <p>This PAC failed to do so.</p> <p>Please let me know if you need additional information.</p> <p>Best Regards,</p> <p>Glen Morgan</p>
