"We've been trying to focus on the game and not look so much at the scoreboard," he said. "They responded really well."

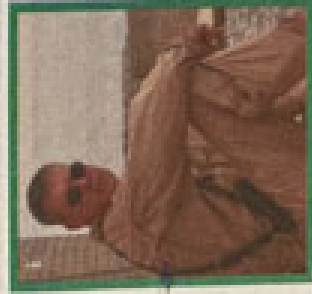
Davis noticed that in those five-set losses, Kamiak ends up not playing its game and tends to tense up.

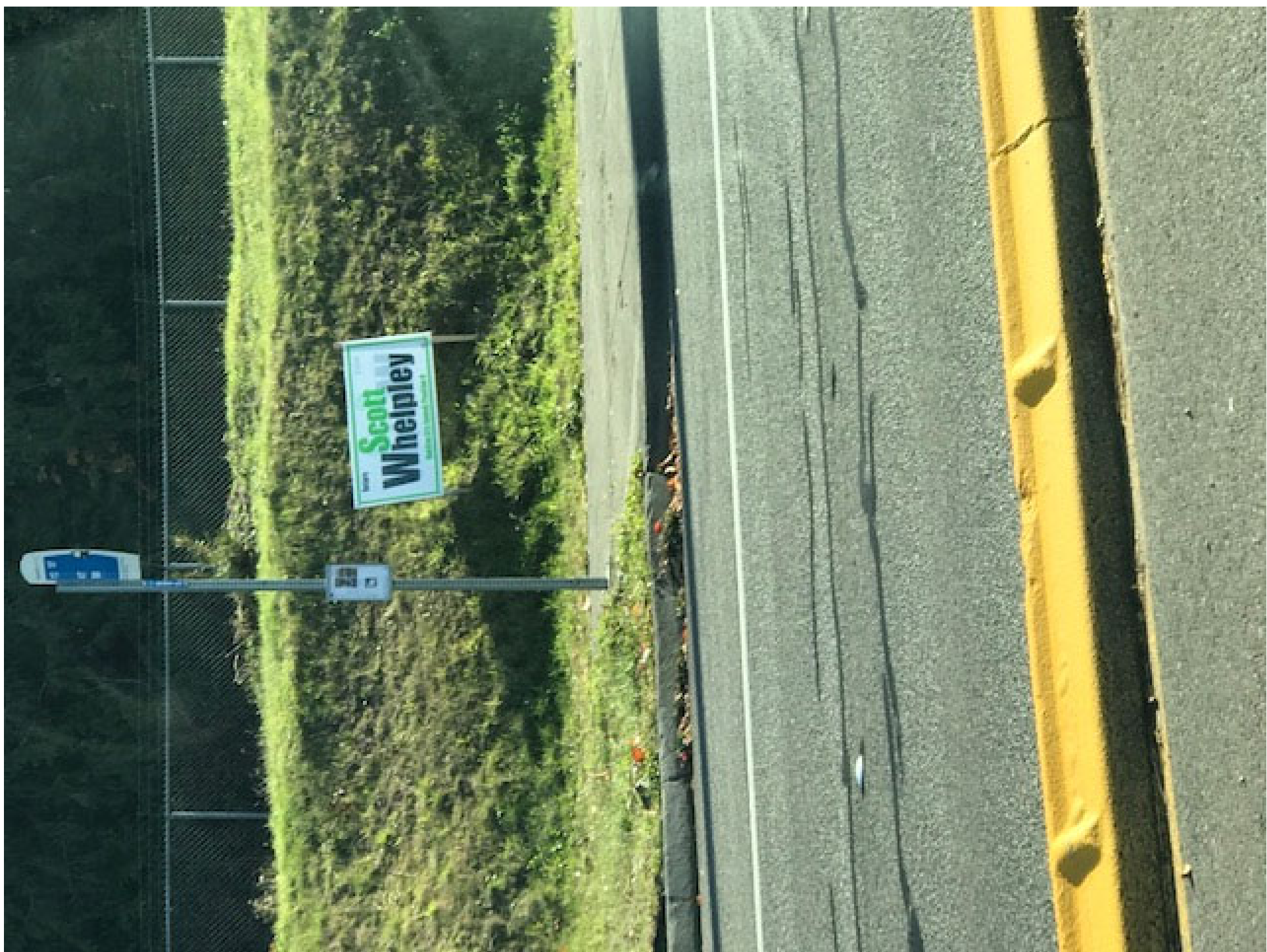
