Public Disclosure Commission Statement of Understanding

DuPont Citizens for Paramedics: PDC Case 59543

Kelly Limata, as a Committee Officer for DuPont Citizens for Paramedics, (Name of Committee Officer) a political committee registered with the PDC to support Proposition #1, a City of DuPont a fire levy lid lift on the November 5, 2019 general election ballot, hereby acknowledge that the Committee:

- Exceeded the \$500 contribution limitations under the Mini Reporting option on August 8, 2019, when the Committee received a \$2,500 monetary contribution from the DuPont Professional Fire Fighters Local 3829 and deposited the check into the Committee bank account. The \$2,500 monetary contribution was \$2,000 over the \$500 contribution limit allowed to have been received from any one source under the Mini Reporting Option, in violation of WAC 390-16-125.

The DuPont Citizens for Paramedics Committee (Committee) would like to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding being scheduled by Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) staff.

Therefore, in lieu of PDC staff scheduling a Hearing, the Committee is completing this Statement of Understanding and enclosing a check or money order in the amount of \$150 as a penalty payment to resolve this matter.

The \$150 penalty being assessed is for the acknowledged violation of WAC 390-16-125 by exceeding the \$500 contribution limitations of the Mini Reporting Option, in accordance with the Penalty Schedule adopted by the Commission for Brief Enforcement Hearings set forth in WAC 390-37-143.

DuPont Citizens for Paramedics Committee understands that by completing this Statement of Understanding, the Committee is acknowledging a violation of Chapter 42.17A RCW and Title 390 WAC set forth above and waiving its right to a hearing in this matter.
