To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that Cydney Moore, running for Burien City Council, has committed numerous violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**), and continues to do so right now during her current campaign.

1) Failure to accurately report expense. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235)

Moore's campaign has already admitted to violating this statute in **PDC Enforcement Case # 57779**, and despite that reminder of the need for her to comply with the statute, her campaign has continued to fail to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures.

For, example, the attached mailer does not appear to be reported on this campaign's C4s even though it was received by voters in the community long before the due date of the last C4. Additionally, this campaign does not appear to disclose postage spent to send these mailers.

Additionally, a professionally produced video was placed by this campaign on their Facebook page (see attached). While it may very well be true that this video was donated as an "in-kind" value by someone to the campaign, that is still a reportable expense.

Additionally, upon review of the flyer, it appears that a professional photograph may have been used, which even if donated to the campaign, this expenditure must be reported as an in-kind contributions

Finally, I will reiterate that this candidate's response to the missing or incomplete information on the filed F1 is not adequate to address the original concerns raised in **PDC Enforcement Case #57779**.

The PDC should conduct a thorough review of this campaign to identify other violations which may have been committed.
