Thank you for speaking to me this morning and providing answers to the questions I asked in my December 26, 2019 email. This email memorializes my questions and your verbal answers. Please review my notes and make any necessary changes. A review by the end of business on **Thursday, January 9, 2020** is appreciated. If I do not hear from you I will assume my recollection is accurate.

The complaint alleges personal use of funds spent on September 9, 2019, to attend the Whatcom Democrat's Eleanor Roosevelt Dinner.

- Please identify the reason for your attendance at this event and specify the cost of consumables. Consumables include the amount paid for food, beverages, event preparation, catering or entertainment cost furnished at the event. (See WAC 390-05-205 for a more complete definition.) - You stated that you attended this event as a candidate, that the county democratic party was supporting your campaign and that the cost you paid for the cost of food (consumables). You also verified that this expenditure did not include a contribution to the Whatcom County Democrats.

The complaint also alleges that your campaign failed to disclose receipt of a contribution in the amount of \$1,000 within 48 hours as required by RCW 417A.265. A review of the 7-day pre-general C-4 shows an in-kind contribution of \$1,000 from Greater Earth Media, Inc. The date received is listed as October 25, 2019 and the C-4 report was submitted on October 29, 2019.

- Please describe your general knowledge about the requirement to disclose monetary and in-kind contributions totaling \$1,000 or more to one source during the 7 days before the primary election and the 21 days before the general. - You stated that you were not aware of the requirement to disclose contributions of \$1,000 in the aggregate received from one source within 48 hours of receipt.
