Failure to register her current 2019 campaign, file C-1 and F-1 forms, prior F-1 form filed in 2018 lists N/A answers to most of the questions on the form. Therefore, she has not disclosed her financial information as required by law. I don't believe that she has nothing to report financially. I've attached a copy of the voter's pamphlet showing that she is currently running for office, position 4 of the Des Moines Pool Board. You can look this information up online for yourself as well. What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Failure to register your campaign or disclose financial information when you are an elected official as required is a threat to transparency and fairness in our democracy. She holds a public office yet does not want to follow the rules that every other public official has to follow. Why should she be on the ballot if she does not meet the requirements as outlined within the law? Elected officials have to be held accountable and the public disclosure laws and reporting are in place to make sure that there are no other personal interests driving their decisions in their public office.
