To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that the Yes for Homes Coalition of San Juan County PAC committed numerous violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) during the 2018 election cycle.

1) Failure to accurately describe expense. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240(6) & WAC 390-16037, RCW 42.17A.235)

This PAC's campaign has regularly failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures. Many C4s this campaign has filed contains violations of the statute and the rules written by the Public Disclosure Commission which support the statute.

Here are some examples that need to be corrected by this PAC's campaign to at least go through the motions of complying with the statute: Examples of a failure to provide sufficient detail of expenditures (unambiguous violations of **RCW 42.17A.240(6)** and **WAC 390-16-037** (see **example B** provided at **WAC 390-16-037(3)**):

For example, the expenditures reported on **PDC Report # 100881076** failed to report how many "signs" were printed and purchased from vendor "Progressive Strategies NW", on 8/13/18 for \$2,545.76. This is a clear violations of **WAC 390-16-037(3) example B** provided. The violations continue. On **PDC Report #100881078**, this PAC failed to provide legally required details for about 12 different transactions related to "ads" or purchase of "mailing" mostly from the "Progressive Strategies NW" vendor. This is clearly legally deficient. This campaign needs to correct these legally deficient filings and properly report all the details and missing expenditures which have been concealed from the public by this campaigns willingness to ignore the law. This was a well-funded political special interest PAC which had professional support and help. They could have followed the law if they had any interest in doing so.

The PDC should investigate and verify whether this campaign is violating other campaign finance laws as well.
