Glen Morgan reported via the portal Fri, 1 Nov 2019 at 8:34AM

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that A Common Purpose PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) in the current 2019 election cycle.

1) Failure to report contributions or expenditures (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)

This well-funded PAC appears to have been recently created as a Single Year Committee (their C1PC was filed on October 23, 2019), and the only other document they filed was a C4 (**PDC Tracking # 100941144** – attached for reference).

However, this information (or lack of information) was false, purposely misleading, and an attempt to conceal their political activities from the PDC and the public.

I have attached a campaign mailer which remains unreported either as debt in the past, or as an expense at this time. Not only is it a mystery to the public how many of these flyers were sent, it is also unknown how much postage was raised, how much money was raised, and the identities of the donors involved in funding this secretive dark money PAC.

Some donors are identified in the mailer's disclaimer, but there is no way to verify that information with the reports filed with the PDC.

The PDC should investigate weird, secretive PACs like this and see what other laws they are violating. These types of flagrant violations of the statute should inspire the PDC to start to impose penalties as those outlined in **RCW 42.17A.750**, if for no other reason than to discourage imitators to stop violating the law with impunity.
