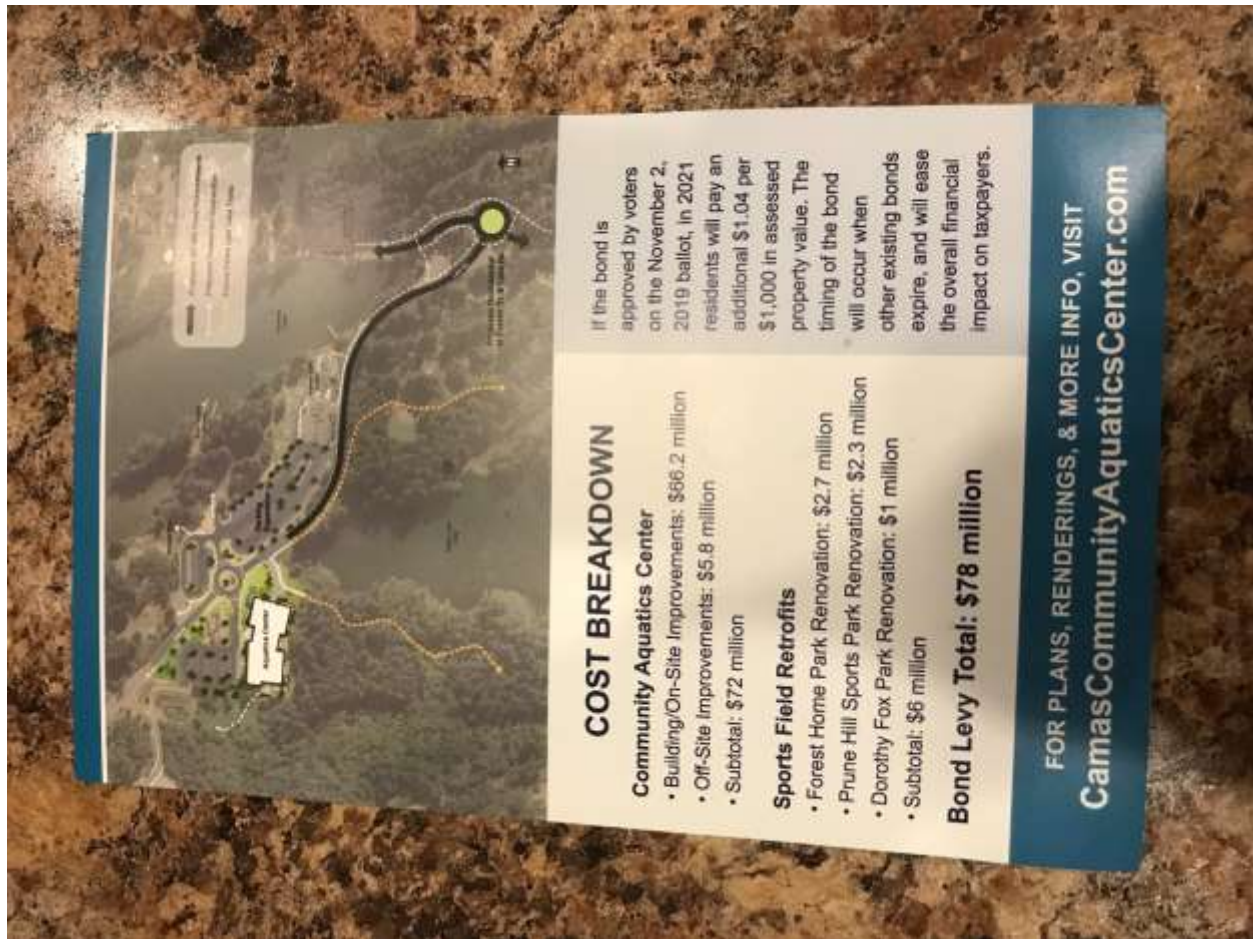

Hello,

Thank you for your email. Here is the information you requested:

1) Yes, I still have the physical flyer. I have attached photos front and back.

2) I did not receive a response to that email, or any additional communication or response from Doug Speas or the yes campaign email address (which Doug controls). However, after one of our neighbors called out Kerry Ticknor personally and publicly on Nextdoor.com (for withholding the information), she private messaged me and asked what information I was requesting. After a couple message exchanges she furnished the requested information. This was on 11/16/19, well after the election had passed. The date is consistent with her voicemail message stating they would not release the information until after the election, and is also consistent with Doug's public statement on Nextdoor.com to the same effect that they would not release any of the information until after the election.

Please don't hesitate to let me know if I can provide any further information.

Additional information is needed regarding your complaint against Yes for Camas Community and Kerry Ticknor (PDC Case 59839). Towards this end, please kindly email me the following information by next **Friday, December 20, 2019:**

In your complaint, you provided a snippet of a Nextdoor.com post wherein Doug Speas said "the YES campaign paid for" the flyer.

- Do you still have the flyer? If so, please email me a copy of the back (reverse) side of the flyer. It would be helpful to see what is written there.

You also indicated that you asked the committee to provide you with the names & occupations of its contributors because this information was missing from the "records" they emailed you on 11/4. You also asked them to supply bank records.

- Did you ever receive any additional records from the committee beyond what they emailed you at 11:45PM on 11/4? If so, please provide me with a copy of what you received.

Any information you can provide is greatly appreciated. Please reply directly to this email string (and do not change the Subject line) so that your response is routed directly to me in our system and retained with the case.
