RE: PDC Alleged Violation/Failure to timely file C1 Report

It is my fault that my C1 was filed late after I filed my candidacy for re-election to Pullman City Council. I thought I had completed the filing successfully in May, and was informed by my treasurer that it had not gone through. As soon as I was aware of this, I filed immediately. My campaign had not received any contributions until that time. This was an honest mistake and not a purposeful action on my part. There was no malicious intent nor was there any deliberate decision to break the law as Mr. Morgan states.

My campaign chose the mini-reporting option because we anticipated contributions would fall beneath the \$5000 limit, and this proved to be true.

Finally, I reported my F1 report on time and will continue to do so annually.

I apologize for my error, for which I take full responsibility, and I will diligently complete any future PDC filings in a timely manner.
