**Re: Washington Fairness Coalition's Response to Craig Keller Complaint
Case No. 60458**

Dear Ms. Fiman:

This firm represents the Washington Fairness Coalition ("WFC"), a Washington political committee, in connection with its response to Mr. Craig Keller's complaint.

Upon further review, WFC acknowledges that the automated calls mistakenly omitted any explicit disclosure that WFC was a sponsor or list WFC's top five contributors. WFC sincerely regrets these inadvertent omissions. Any violation of RCW 42.17A.320 was unintentional.

Apart from this isolated mistake, WFC has a strong history of compliance. In addition, the campaign spent only \$8100.90 on the automated calls, a small fraction of the campaign's total expenditures of approximately \$1.3 million. Considering this history and that the I-1000 campaign is over, WFC respectfully requests that the PDC exercise its discretion to not fine WFC under these circumstances, and instead issue a warning.
