After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of a complaint filed December 5, 2019 by Steve Finley against FedEx, PDC staff opened a formal investigation and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) on March 3, 2020, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

At the hearing it was noted that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints through the use of alternatives to non-compliance, and I am encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.
