Subject: Complaint regarding Jami Lund, PDC Case 61764

Dear Peter Starzynski:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on December 23, 2019. The complaint alleged that Jami Lund, a 2019 candidate for School Director for Centralia School District 401 may have violated RCW 42.17A.240 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), disclosing contributions and expenditures, including details, undertaken by the Campaign.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response provided by the Respondent; the applicable PDC reports filed by the Respondent; and queried the Respondent’s data in the PDC contribution and expenditure database to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff’s review, we found the following:

- Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.240 and WAC 390-16-037 the Respondent is required to disclose the purpose of expenditures clearly on C-4 reports.
- The Respondent filed C-4 reports missing number of items printed, and number of items mailed, missing vendor address for Voter-Science, ad run dates, as well as ad information and unclear description on a refund issued to contributors William & Vicky Brumfield.
- Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.240 and WAC 390-16-034 the Respondent is required to disclose, in addition to the name and address of each person who has made one or more contributions in the aggregate amount of more than one hundred dollars, their occupation, and the name and address of their employer.
- The Respondent filed C-3, report number 100940956, dated 10/27/19 missing contributor’s address information on eight different contributors.
- The Respondent submitted amended reports to include all missing data on January 9, 2020 and January 21, 2020.
- Although the Respondent was subject to a prior complaint alleging similar allegations of lack of disclosure details, the complaint was resolved after this complaint had been received.

Based on our findings staff has determined that, in this instance, failure to timely accurately disclosure of contribution and expenditure details on C-3 and C-4 reports does not amount to a violation that warrants further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Jami Lund about the importance of the timely and accurate disclosure of all contribution and expenditure activities, and the timely and accurate filings of all future PDC reports in accordance with the statutes and rules.

The PDC encourages you to review the Candidate Instructions and the many other guides and videos available in the Learn, Guides and training videos section of the www.pdc.wa.gov website to further understand the rules for candidates.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
