# What's on the ballot for our students and schools in the February 11 election?

North Thurston Public Schools has two funding measures on the February 11 ballot to help the district reach our strategic plan goals to create thriving schools that foster learning, academic growth, critical thinking, and student success after graduation.

## Proposition 1: Renewal of our Educational Programs and Operations Levy

This will fund STEM education programs, college and career readiness, staffing positions such as teachers, nurses, mental health specialists and school counselors, and funds opportunities for students like robotics, art, drama, music and athletics.

## Proposition 2: Capital Bond

This will fund safety and security improvements at every school, as well as major renovation at River Ridge High School and Komachin Middle School and "warm and dry" improvements to several older schools including Meadows, Seven Oaks and Horizons Elementary. The bond also covers maintenance improvements at every school, as well as investment in community-shared playgrounds and athletic field reinvestments. It requires 60 percent approval.

If approved, the estimated combined rate per \$1,000 of assessed value would be lower than what taxpayers have approved in the past.\*

Levy Rate **\$2.50**
