The Bellevue School District is running paid advertisements on Facebook promoting its upcoming bond measure. I allege this to be an illegal use of agency facilities in support of the bond measure campaign. I maintain that these advertisements exceed the normal and regular conduct of the agency. I also maintain that the content of the advertisements are not a permitted "objective and fair presentation of facts", but campaign language. The statement that the bond "ensures equity in our district" is not a realistic statement of fact.
