The loan Mr. Freed made to his campaign enabled him to gain support by the Washington State Republican Caucus, before other candidates could. While loans are permitted, loan repayments of over \$6,000 are not allowed per RCW. His loan of \$500,000 and subsequent repayment nearly four months later game him a significant advantage over other candidates.
