"Thank you so much for sending this my way, Tabatha. First and foremost, thank you for continuing to work and keep our government accountable despite this pandemic.

In response to this complaint, I believe the photos submitted as 'evidence' make it pretty clear that no violation occurred: I shared a campaign event on my public campaign Facebook page and the Everett Public Schools-WA shared that public posting. Neither myself nor my campaign can control who shares my content, if there is an issue, we can take that up with the entity that shared the post, but again I cannot control who shares that content.

The event in question was a celebration of Juneteenth, not a fundraiser or some kind of tacky political event. This event was to commemorate centuries of slavery and celebrate the freedom of black Americans and our basic freedoms for all Americans and I will stand behind this event 100%. If there is something I can do to help mitigate any potential violations, please let me know and I'll be more than happy to comply — but I do not know how I can possibly stop someone from sharing a public Facebook post!
