Subject: Complaint regarding Dale England, PDC Case 73519

Dear Shawn Minton:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on July 8, 2020. The complaint alleged that Dale England (Respondent), candidate for County Commissioner in Chelan County may have violated RCW 42.17A.700 for failing to timely file Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1).

PDC staff reviewed the allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the responses provided by the Respondent; the applicable PDC reports filed by the Respondent; and queried the Respondent’s data in the PDC database to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff’s review, we found the following:

- Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.700 the Respondent is required to file their F-1 within two weeks of becoming a candidate.
- The Respondent filed the required F-1 on April 9, 2020 and the campaign started on March 9, 2020 making the F-1 seventeen (17) days beyond the statutory requirement of being filed within two weeks of becoming a candidate, March 23, 2020.
- The Respondent is a first-time candidate.
- The Respondent has not had any violations with the PDC within the past five years.

Based on our findings staff has determined that, in this instance, failure to timely file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1) does not amount to a violation that warrants further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Dale England about the importance of the timely filing of the F-1, and the timely filing of all future PDC reports in accordance with the statutes and rules.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
