Re: Alleged Violation of RCW 42.17A.235

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter responds to the complaint from Mr. Glen Morgan that the Commission received on July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Mr. Morgan alleges that Smith for 17<sup>th</sup> LD violated reporting requirements. As a first-time candidate, Mr. Daniel Smith's campaign has tried to comply with all applicable legal requirements. Below I address the alleged violations identified in Mr. Morgan's complaint.

**1. Failure to sufficiently describe expenditures.**

Mr. Morgan identified a sign printing expense that only lacked the quantity printed on the C4 covering 4/1-4/30. This expense was reported on time and represents 1% of all expenditures to date. We have amended this report to add that 15 signs were printed. As of July 1<sup>st</sup>, the campaign transitioned treasurers, which provided an opportunity to ensure all expenditures have been properly reported.
