Subject: Complaint regarding Hollie Huthman, PDC Case 73784

Dear Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on July 13, 2020. Your complaint alleged that Hollie Huthman, an incumbent at-large City Councilmember for the City of Bellingham, may have violated RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement report (F-1) by April 15, 2020.

PDC staff reviewed the applicable statute(s), rule(s), and reporting requirement(s) related to the annual Personal Financial Affairs Statement.

Based on staff review, we found the following:

- On April 29, 2020, the PDC staff did an electronic outreach via email reminding Ms. Huthman that she had not filed her F-1 report for 2019, that was due no later than April 15, 2020.
- On June 13, 2020, the PDC received a complaint from you alleging violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file a F-1 report.
- On August 10, 2020, six days after the 2020 Primary Election, Ms. Huthman filed a Personal Financial Affairs Statement report (F-1) with the PDC.

While our review found that Hollie Huthman failed to timely file a Personal Statement of Financial Affairs (F-1) report that was due no later than April 15, 2020, we found no prior PDC violations against her.

However, pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), Hollie Huthman will receive a formal written warning concerning the failure to timely file a Personal Statement of Financial Affairs (F-1) report as required by law. Ms. Huthman will be informed the Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
