<p>Glen Morgan (Wed, 15 Jul 2020 at 5:35 PM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that State Representative Tana Senn (41st LD) has has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A) by misusing her surplus funds account. The details of these violations are as follows:</p> <p>1) Illegal contribution from candidate surplus account to PAC (Violation of RCW 42.17A.430(8) and WAC 390-16-234(3))</p> <p>As RCW 42.17A.430(8), which deals with the disposal of surplus accounts clearly states:</p> <p>"No candidate or authorized committee may transfer funds to any other candidate or other political committee."</p> <p>Yet, despite this prohibition on making illegal contributions like this, this candidate's surplus fund chose to contribute these funds regardless. For evidence see PDC Report # 100981407 (See attached), this candidate's surplus account made an illegal \$1000 contribution from the Eastside Democratic Dinner Committee PAC which is a specifically prohibited contribution and these funds must be reimbursed immediately. Please note, despite using the Democratic Party name in the title of this PAC, it is clearly registered as a continuing political committee (See their C1PC attached), which is an explicitly prohibited party for receiving surplus funds from this candidate's surplus account. This violation is a serious one and must be corrected immediately.</p> <p>Please feel free to let me know if you need any further information in this case.</p> <p>Best Regards,</p> <p>Glen Morgan</p>
