To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that the Eastside Democratic Dinner Committee PAC (A registered continuing political action committee) has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) once again. The details of these violations are as follows:

**1) Failure to report contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)**

This PAC appears to have failed to report a \$500 contribution which appears to have been contributed to this PAC by the King County Democratic Central Committee on June 24, 2020 (See attached **PDC Report # 100983483**). This report clearly details a \$500 contribution that was never reported by the Eastside Democratic Dinner Committee. This PAC needs to stop concealing contributions from the public and start disclosing the truth.

**2) Acceptance of illegal contribution from candidate surplus account (Violation of RCW 42.17A.430(8))**

As **RCW 42.17A.430(8)**, which deals with the disposal of surplus accounts clearly states:

"No candidate or authorized committee may transfer funds to any other candidate or other political committee."

Yet, despite this prohibition on accepting illegal sources of contributions like this, this PAC chose to accept these funds regardless. For example on **PDC Report # 100977657 (See attached)**, this PAC accepted an illegal \$1000 contribution from the "Friends of Tana Senn Surplus Account" which is a specifically prohibited contribution and these funds must be reimbursed immediately. While the core legal violation here was committed by the Tana Senn campaign, this violation is a serious one and must be corrected immediately.

Please be aware, this PAC has a history of egregious violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws, as evidenced by the fact the Washington State Attorney General filed a lawsuit against this secretive dark money PAC and finally settled this lawsuit on March 6, 2018 (**see attached \$6, 925 stipulation and judgment**). It should be noted that this secretive PAC is still within the 4 year probationary period referenced in that original judgement, and they may be subject to owing the \$1,392 which had been suspended as a condition of four years of compliance, which they seem to be failing at right now.

5 The parties to this stipulation, Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), and  
6 Defendant, EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered  
7 political committee, desiring to resolve all claims arising out of the State's complaint, hereby  
8 enter into the following stipulation:

9 1. Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered  
10 political committee, agrees to pay the State an assessed civil penalty in the amount of  
11 \$2,785 for its violations of RCW 42.17A for failing to timely disclose its contributions and  
12 independent expenditures made in 2016.

13 2. The parties agree that \$1,392.50 of the assessed civil penalty will be suspended based on  
14 the following terms and conditions:

15 a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the  
16 Judgment. During the period of suspension, Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC  
17 DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, agrees that  
18 it will not violate any provision of RCW 42.17A.

19 b. In the event Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a  
20 Washington registered political committee, is found by the Public Disclosure  
21 Commission or a court to have committed a violation of RCW 42.17A during the  
22 suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$1,392 will immediately become due  
23 and payable within 30 days of such finding without further intervention of the  
24 Court.

25 c. If Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington  
26 registered political committee, is not found to have committed violations of RCW

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42.17A by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court for conduct during the suspension period, then the suspended portion of the penalty will be set aside.

3. Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, agrees to pay the State the total amount of \$4,140 as reasonable attorney fees, court costs, and costs of investigation in this action.



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**JUDGMENT**

THIS MATTER came on regularly before the undersigned judge of the above-entitled Court. Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), appearing through its attorneys of record, LINDA A. DALTON, Senior Assistant Attorney General, and KELLY R. HARMON, Assistant Attorney General, and Defendant, EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, appearing through its attorney, LAURA EWAN, apprised the Court of their agreement to the entry of this judgment for the purpose of settling and compromising this action brought under RCW 42.17A. The Court, having reviewed the records and files herein, and having found the settlement to be a just and proper resolution of this matter, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Defendant, EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE is hereby assessed a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A, in the amount of \$2,785 payable to the State of Washington.
2. The amount of \$1,392.50 of the assessed penalty is hereby suspended upon Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE's compliance with the following court-ordered conditions:
  - a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the Judgment. During the period of suspension, Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, will not violate any provision of RCW 42.17A.
  - b. In the event Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, is found by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court to have committed a violation of RCW 42.17A during the suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$1,392.50 shall immediately become

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due and payable within 30 days of such finding without further intervention of the Court.


c. If Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, is not found to have committed violations of RCW 42.17A by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court for conduct during the suspension period, then the suspended portion of the penalty shall be set aside.


Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee shall pay the State of Washington the amount of \$3,400.00 as reasonable attorney fees, \$240 in court costs, and \$500 in costs of investigation, authorized under RCW 42.17A.765 in this action.

3. Defendant EASTSIDE DEMOCRATIC DINNER COMMITTEE, a Washington registered political committee, shall pay the State the unsuspended portion of the civil penalty (\$1,392.50), reasonable attorneys fees (\$3,400), and assessed costs (\$740) within 30 days from the date of the entry of the Judgment
