To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that the Eastside Democratic Dinner Committee PAC (A registered continuing political action committee) has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) once again. The details of these violations are as follows:

1) Failure to report contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)

This PAC appears to have failed to report a \$500 contribution which appears to have been contributed to this PAC by the King County Democratic Central Committee on June 24, 2020 (See attached **PDC Report # 100983483**). This report clearly details a \$500 contribution that was never reported by the Eastside Democratic Dinner Committee. This PAC needs to stop concealing contributions from the public and start disclosing the truth.

2) Acceptance of illegal contribution from candidate surplus account (Violation of RCW 42.17A.430(8))

As RCW 42.17A.430(8), which deals with the disposal of surplus accounts clearly states:

"No candidate or authorized committee may transfer funds to any other candidate or other political committee."

Yet, despite this prohibition on accepting illegal sources of contributions like this, this PAC chose to accept these funds regardless. For example on **PDC Report # 100977657 (See attached)**, this PAC accepted an illegal \$1000 contribution from the "Friends of Tana Senn Surplus Account" which is a specifically prohibited contribution and these funds must be reimbursed immediately. While the core legal violation here was committed by the Tana Senn campaign, this violation is a serious one and must be corrected immediately.

Please be aware, this PAC has a history of egregious violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws, as evidenced by the fact the Washington State Attorney General filed a lawsuit against this secretive dark money PAC and finally settled this lawsuit on March 6, 2018 (**see attached \$6, 925 stipulation and judgment**). It should be noted that this secretive PAC is still within the 4 year probationary period referenced in that original judgement, and they may be subject to owing the \$1,392 which had been suspended as a condition of four years of compliance, which they seem to be failing at right now.
