Hi Bridgette,

I am writing to follow up with you regarding our phone conversation of Tuesday (9/29) wherein you indicated that you have effectively withdrawn as a candidate due to family medical reasons. I have confirmed with my colleagues that you can submit a *Statement of Termination of Campaign* form (commonly referred to as a Withdrawal Statement) to the PDC, indicating that you terminated your campaign, are not campaigning, and, if elected, will not accept the office. While this will not update the information on file with Elections officials, it will relieve you of the requirement to submit a C-1 report and a F-1 report to the PDC.

Hi Bridgette,

Thank you for your email. Do know (approximately) what day you mailed us the Withdrawal Statement? As of today, we have not received your statement.

I plan to mention the situation to the Commission, but it will ultimately be their decision how to proceed if the Withdrawal Statement is not received before the date of the Hearing.

You strongly urge you to resubmit a signed Withdrawal Statement by email or mail, but we would need to receive it by **Tues. 10/20**. Unfortunately, we cannot accept this item in-person at our Olympia office because we are working remotely due to COVID-19. If you do decide to mail the statement to us again, we recommend that you do so by tomorrow (10/16) and use delivery tracking. Finally, please be aware that state mail is received and delivered by CMS, which adds one day to delivery times.

I hope this information is helpful. I will be out of the office on furlough tomorrow but will be back in the office on Mon. 10/19.

Hi Bridgette,

I want to provide you with some additional information regarding the upcoming Hearing as you do have a couple of options:

If your signed Withdrawal Statement doesn't arrive by tomorrow and you are unable to provide a digital copy, I would encourage you to participate in the Hearing. However, you can do this either in writing (an email will suffice) or by phone.

- If you opt to participate in writing, please kindly email me the information you want the Commissioners to know and I will be happy to present it to them on your behalf. The Presiding Officer will take your statement into consideration when determining penalties. In your written statement, it would be helpful to explain
 - 1) when and why you withdrew as a candidate;
 - 2) Elections officials were unable to remove your name from the ballot;
 - 3) you mailed a Withdrawal Statement to the PDC on X date; and
 - 4) why you cannot scan and email the Withdrawal Statement, etc.

OR

- If you wish to participate verbally by phone, please email me your preferred phone number and we will call you the day of the Hearing. I cannot give you an exact time for the call (as we are hearing several cases that day) but we would likely be calling you around 10:30AM.

If you plan to participate in writing or by phone, please kindly let me know by end-of-business today (10/19).

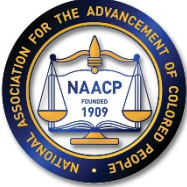

I hereby acknowledge that I, Bridgette Fahnbulleh

(Printed Name of Respondent)

did not timely file the required Candidate Registration (C-1 Report) and Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 Report) with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) as required for a candidate seeking elected office in 2020. The C-1 and F-1 Reports were due to be filed within two weeks of my becoming a candidate in the 2020 election, or no later than June 1, 2020, thereby violating RCW 42.17A.205 and RCW 42.17A.700.

I want to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Hearing (Brief Enforcement Hearing) before the Presiding Officer. Therefore, I am filing both the C-1 and F-1 reports, completing the Statement of Understanding, and enclosing a check or money order in the amount of \$200 (\$100 for each late filed report), in lieu of an October 21, 2020, Brief Enforcement hearing being held.

I understand that this will resolve all issues with the PDC regarding my failure to timely file the C-1 and F-1 reports, provided that a check or money order for \$200, your missing reports are completed on-line, and this signed Statement of Understanding are all received by Thursday, October 15, 2020.

I further understand that Commission staff will not be scheduling a Brief Enforcement hearing before the Presiding Officer regarding my obligation to timely file the C-1 and F-1 report that were due within two weeks of becoming a candidate.
