<p>joe Hyer (Mon, 5 Oct 2020 at 10:27 AM)</p> <p>On it's 8/31/20 C4 filing, the Region PAC lists \$100 in debt to its sole committee member, Jon Pettit.</p> <p>Mr. Pettit DID loan the PAC \$100, in early July. However, he also repaid the loan in full on the C4 of 7/28/20.</p> <p>The PAC Received a total of \$10,100 in once contribution and one loan. They report disbursing \$9733.90 (in two installments) in mailers for 'Bud Blake', and a loan repayment to Jon Pettit of \$100.00. - That would put the PAC account balance at \$266.10.</p> <p>However, the PAC reported a balance of just \$166.10 - and an outstanding debt to its creator, Jon Pettit, of \$100. There is no record of this second loan. There is no record of a second \$100 deposited for this loan. If the creator of the PAC is taking payments, that's legal, but report it.</p> <p>As it is, the books are inaccurate, and the second loan must be fully disclosed, and the records updated.</p>
What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
Inaccurate reporting of contributions, debt and cash on hand serves to shroud real finances involved in electioneering - violating the very purpose of public disclosure laws
