<p>RCW 42.17A.240 states that “Each report required under RCW 42.17A.235 (1) through (4) must be certified as correct by the treasurer and the candidate and shall disclose the following, except an incidental committee only must disclose and certify as correct the information required under subsections (2)(d) and (6) of this section...(6) The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures.”</p> <p>Kevin Ballard, a current DuPont City Council member, is a candidate for the House of Representatives in the 28th Legislative District. On May 28th, his campaign held a campaign event in a restaurant that was supposed to be closed due to COVID-19. His campaign C4 does not show any expense or in-kind for holding this event. According to RCW 42.17A.240, all expenditures need to be reported, both the dollar amount of the expenditure as well as the purpose of the expenditure. This is perhaps the most basic tenant of our transparent elections — disclosing what your campaign is spending money on. This principle ensures voters can keep candidates accountable, and in the most basic form, bars candidates from using campaign contributions for personal or inappropriate use. The PDC clearly states that these expenditures must be reported on the “10th of each month to cover preceding calendar month,” Kevin Ballard has failed to do that.</p> <p>Kevin Ballard’s campaign posts and photos clearly show the use of this closed facility, and nowhere has this expenditure been reported. This puts his campaign in violation of RCW 42.17A.240 and this failure of reporting must be rectified.</p>

<p>RCW 42.17A.240 states that “Each report required under RCW 42.17A.235 (1) through (4) must be certified as correct by the treasurer and the candidate and shall disclose the following, except an incidental committee only must disclose and certify as correct the information required under subsections (2)(d) and (6) of this section...(6) The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures.”</p> <p>Kevin Ballard, a current DuPont City Council member, is a candidate for the House of Representatives in the 28th Legislative District. On his campaign Facebook page, Kevin posted several photographs of campaign T-shirts on June 11th and again on June 25th. According to RCW 42.17A.240, all expenditures need to be reported, both the dollar amount of the expenditure as well as the purpose of the expenditure. This is perhaps the most basic tenant of our transparent elections — disclosing what your campaign is spending money on. This principle ensures voters can keep candidates accountable, and in the most basic form, bars candidates from using campaign contributions for personal or inappropriate use. The PDC clearly states that these expenditures must be reported on the “10th of each month to cover preceding calendar month,” Kevin Ballard has failed to do that.</p> <p>Kevin Ballard’s campaign photos clearly show the fundraiser and acquisition of campaign T-shirts and nowhere has this expenditure been reported. This puts his campaign in violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 and this failure of reporting must be rectified.</p>

Multiple photographs have been attached that show Kevin Ballard’s purchased T-shirts that need to be reported. In addition, the names of folks who purchased these shirts are not fully noted in the contribution page. The contributions of Chris Harper and Judy Hazler don’t appear to be reported on the 7.27 C3 report as other names as applicable as small contributions noted on a C3.

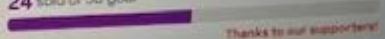

<b>What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?</b>
<p>RCW 42.17A.240 states that “Each report required under RCW 42.17A.235 (1) through (4) must be certified as correct by the treasurer and the candidate and shall disclose the following, except an incidental committee only must disclose and certify as correct the information required under subsections (2)(d) and (6) of this section...(6) The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures.”</p> <p>Kevin Ballard, a current DuPont City Council, is a candidate for the House of Representatives in the 28th Legislative District. His campaign C4 reports did not timely list expenditures for treasury services for the months of April to October, listing them in the July C4 report. According to RCW 42.17A.240, all expenditures need to be reported, both the dollar amount of the expenditure as well as the purpose of the expenditure. This is perhaps the most basic tenant of our transparent elections — disclosing what your campaign is spending money on. This principle ensures voters can keep candidates accountable, and in the most basic form, bars candidates from using campaign contributions for personal or inappropriate use. The PDC clearly states that these expenditures must be reported on the “10th of each month to cover preceding calendar month,” Kevin Ballard has also failed to report treasury expenses for July, August, September, and October as evidenced in C4 reports.</p> <p>Kevin Ballard’s campaign has used treasury services through each month of the campaign, but this expenditure has not been reported within the relevant timeframes, with only one treasury expenditure reported for July, but reported in previous or subsequent C4 reports. This flagrant error puts his campaign in violation of RCW 42.17A.240 and this failure of reporting must be rectified. This appears especially malicious or willfully hiding expenses as the Treasurer used for Mr. Ballard’s campaign is a treasurer for other candidates as well with years of experience.</p>

Failure to file adequate or accurate expenditure details on photography expenses.
<b>What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?</b>
<p>RCW 42.17A.240 states that “Each report required under RCW 42.17A.235 (1) through (4) must be certified as correct by the treasurer and the candidate and shall disclose the following, except an incidental committee only must disclose and certify as correct the information required under subsections (2)(d) and (6) of this section...(6) The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures.”</p> <p>Kevin Ballard, a currency DuPont City Council member, is a candidate for the House of Representatives in the 28th Legislative District. Kevin Ballard’s campaign failed to adequately report expenditures on photography services used for campaign photoshoots or photography shots on his mailer. According to RCW 42.17A.240, all expenditures need to be reported, both the dollar amount of the expenditure as well as the purpose of the expenditure. This is perhaps the most basic tenant of our transparent elections — disclosing what your campaign is spending money on. This principle ensures voters can keep candidates accountable, and in the most basic form, bars candidates from using campaign contributions for personal or inappropriate use. The PDC clearly states that these expenditures must be reported on the “10th of each month to cover preceding calendar month,” Kevin Ballard has failed to do so.</p> <p>Kevin Ballard’s campaign’s use of photography services as evidenced by their campaign’s output on their website, social media, and mailer indicates a flagrant failure to follow PDC reporting rules regarding a full accounting of expenditures. This puts his campaign in violation of RCW 42.17A.240 and this failure of reporting must be rectified.</p>

<b>Failure to properly attribute campaign information and party. 10.18 Article in The Suburban Times does not include paid for and party information, while candidate asks for votes.</b>
<b>What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?</b>
<p>RCW 42.17A.320 states that “(1) All written political advertising, whether relating to candidates or ballot propositions, shall include the sponsor's name and address. All radio and television political advertising, whether relating to candidates or ballot propositions, shall include the sponsor's name. The use of an assumed name for the sponsor of electioneering communications, independent expenditures, or political advertising shall be unlawful. For partisan office, if a candidate has expressed a party or independent preference on the declaration of candidacy, that party or independent designation shall be clearly identified in electioneering communications, independent expenditures, or political advertising..”</p> <p>Kevin Ballard, a current DuPont City Council member, is a candidate for the House of Representatives in the 28th Legislative District. On October 18th, his campaign submitted an article in The Suburban Times, but did not include information regarding who paid for the communication, the address of the campaign, or the party information. According to RCW 42.17A.320, specific identifying information must be included on all written political advertising, namely who paid for the communication, the campaign address, and the candidate’s party preference.</p> <p>Kevin Ballard has failed to include this identifying information on the October 18th article in The Suburban Times in which votes are asked for.</p>
