Subject: Staff-generated complaint, PDC Case 80156

Dear Christopher Reed:

On November 17, 2020, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file Personal Financial Affairs Statement within two weeks of becoming a candidate.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- There are two Registrations (C-1 reports) on file for you as a candidate for County Commissioner, filed on September 10, 2019, and for House of Representatives District 10, filed on June 3, 2019.
- Your F-1 was filed on July 8, 2020 under the County Commissioner campaign; leaving the State Representative campaign showing in our system as having no F-1 filed.
- Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.700(5) no individual may be required to file more than once in any calendar year.

PDC staff will now close PDC Case 80156 administratively and remove your name from our hearing list.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a) and WAC 390-37-060(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
