Dear Myron Huie:

On November 17, 2020, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement for Calendar Year 2019.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- You filed your Personal Financial Affairs Statement on November 18, 2020.
- Your Statement of Understanding and payment of \$100 were received on November 25, 2020 in the PDC office.

Huie Myron completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$100 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement for Calendar Year 2019. The \$100 penalty assessed resolves the allegations listed in your complaint.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
