Subject: Staff-generated complaint, PDC Case 80244

Dear Ryan McIrvin:

On November 17, 2020, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file the annual Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) disclosing financial activities for calendar year 2019.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- Ryan McIrvin (the “Respondent”) served as a City Council Member for the City of Renton for the term January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023.
- As an elected or appointed official who held office in 2020, the Respondent was due to file an F-1 report with the PDC disclosing 2019 activities no later than April 15, 2020.
- The Respondent filed an F-1 report with the PDC on November 18, 2020.
- The Respondent completed a *Statement of Understanding* (SOU) and paid a \$100 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging a violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failing to timely file the F-1 report. The \$100 penalty assessed resolves the allegation listed in this case.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
