Subject: Staff-generated complaint, PDC Case 83341

Dear Tom Taylor:

On January 11, 2021, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.205 and 700 for failure to timely file Candidate Registration (C-1) and Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1) within two weeks of becoming a candidate.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- The Respondent registered as a Write-In Candidate for State Representative for Legislative District 03 on July 16, 2020.
- The deadline for filing the required C-1 and F-1 would have been July 30, 2020.
- The Respondent filed the required F-1 on January 12, 2021 with the PDC.
- The Respondent filed the required C-1 on January 15, 2021 with the PDC.
- The F-1 was filed 166 days late and the C-1 was filed 169 days late.
- The Respondent stated they were unaware you were required to file with the PDC as a write-in candidate.
- The Respondent stated they never intended to run for office.

PDC staff will now close PDC Case 83341 administratively and remove your name from our hearing list.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a) and WAC 390-37-060(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
